

Colorado Koinonia Weekend Scholarship Guidelines

It is the intent of the Board or Colorado Koinonia (the Board) **to make provision for as many new participants into the Koinonia community as possible.**

We encourage participants and team members to meet registration fees 100 percent (independently)

A sponsoring Koinonian may underwrite registration fees 100 percent for one or more participants or team members at any time

For those requiring scholarships, the Board has outlined guidelines:

- **50 percent of the registration to be covered by scholarship** with first-time participants taking responsibility either to pay and/or meet the balance through individual fundraising
- **30 percent of the registration to be covered by scholarship** with first-time team members taking responsibility either to pay and/or meet the balance through individual fundraising
- **20 percent of the registration to be covered by scholarship** with second-time team members taking responsibility either to pay and/or meet the balance through individual fundraising
- **0 percent of the registration to be covered by scholarship thereafter**

If scholarship wasn't required as a participant, guidelines do not translate as 50 percent as a first-time team member, or 30 percent as a second-time team member. Rather, guidelines are intended to provide a simple outline for making provision for as many as possible, encouraging participants and team members to invest in their own Koinonia experience while planting seed to make provision for others.

The Assistant Lay Leader will work closely with the Lay Leader and the Treasurer **to communicate scholarship needs** at the team meetings and to the CK community, and **to maintain an accurate accounting of the team member scholarships.**

As a Team Member if scholarship funds are needed, you must let the Assistant Lay Leader know before the 2nd team meeting. Please use the CK Fundraising letter as a tool to help raise funds for your weekend payment.
